
WELCOME TO AMSTERDAM

NEWS FROM THE CHAPTERS



The Foundation for Orthopedic Trauma (FOT) held its 9th Annual Meeting and a Lower Extremity Dissection Course in Las Vegas, February 1 and 2, 2018. Topics ranged from new techniques in orthopedic trauma, FOT funded research to interactive case presentations. Two Haitian residents were invited as part of the long standing educational cooperation with Haiti.

Message from the FOT President Dr. Daniel Horwitz: "FOT continues to grow and it remains a leader in trauma education in the United States. Our resident cadaveric dissection courses remain oversubscribed and research funding continues to produce publications and worldwide podium presentations. Our active membership has positioned us as a core element of the OTA, and we look forward to increased participation in OTC activities worldwide".

Task Force Education

An editorial panel with Taco Blokhuis, Micha Holla and Oliver Trapp met in Amsterdam, 20–21 March 2018, to analyze results of the chapter education survey covering 2015–2017. A comprehensive OTCF education status report will be presented to the GA in June 2018. All OTC chapters are thanked for having responded with detailed data on courses, faculty and evaluation forms.

RESEARCH GRANTS 2018

Based upon the Malaga workshop (see above), the OTCF Research Committee now invites proposals for the 2018 grant cycle in the following areas:

- **Implant-Bone Interface:** Coatings, Fixation, Minimizing Infection
- **Prevention and Treatment of Infection:** Type and length of antibiotic treatment, stability of fractures
- **Post-traumatic Deformity:** Angular deformities and consequences, pediatric fracture deformities
- **Role of External Fixation in Acute Trauma:** Staged protocols, span and scan – timing of internal fixation, timing of fixation (systemic)
- **External Fixation and Fracture Repair:** Optimal stiffness, External fixation in osteoporotic bone, Assessment of healing after external fixation

UPCOMING EVENTS 2018




OTCF General Assembly, Amsterdam, 7 June 2018
